

2016 ACE Student Survey

Nearly 150 high school students from the Portland metro area participated in the ACE Mentor Program of Oregon in 2016. Here's what they said about their experience.

CAREER READINESS



gained knowledge and skills not taught in their high school

- 93% learned life and work skills that will help in any career
- **92%** agree ACE gave them useful information about careers in the design/construction industry
- **75%** felt ACE made them more **motivated to go to college** or enter a skilled trades training program
- **78%** think participating in ACE probably improved their chances of being admitted to college or a skilled trades training program
- **74%** agree that ACE has given them a **professional network** that will help them to advance their careers
- 99% learned how the different disciplines in the design/construction industry work together to create and build a structure
- 68% felt that their studies in high school became more meaningful

SKILLS



improved their ability to work collaboratively as part of a team

- 88% gained leadership experience and skills
- **75%** learned something about how to negotiate
- **75%** became more effective problem-solvers
- 80% strengthened their sense of creativity
- 80% learned how to work better with people whose backgrounds and ideas are different from their own
- 85% improved their ability to communicate orally in small groups and before large audiences
- 86% learned better how to communicate graphically (e.g. sketches, diagrams, renderings)
- **70%** learned how to manage time more effectively
