
The Portland Workforce Alliance is an independent nonprofit that sees young people as the key to our region's long-term economic prosperity and quality of life.

Construction Craft Laborer Apprenticeship

Construction Craft Laborers perform complex and physically demanding tasks that require critical thinking a technical skills. Apprenticeship training prepares you for a career by building a strong foundation of knowledge and skills. Construction employers must have a skilled workforce to complete projects on time and under budget. Owners of construction projects expect contractors to have a skilled workforce that produces a quality project, capable of working as a member of a team and have basic problem-solving and math skills. Employers want workers who are hard-working, reliable, and diligent about being on time. Oregon-Southern Idaho Laborers-Employers Training Trust Apprenticeship Program is a 2-3 year program requiring 4,000 hours of on-the-job (OJT) training and a minimum of 120 hours of related class instruction in core courses and electives in each year of the program for completion.

Minimum Qualifications: Eighteen (18) years of age. Applicant must have a High School diploma, GED, Certificate of High School Equivalency. Work Keys Bronze Level Career Readiness Certificate, or complete a validated Community College test to establish equivalent competency in reading, writing, comprehension and math skills. Applicant must demonstrate capacity to complete the five job related tasks listed in our4 Hands-On Skills Assessment.

Selection Process: The committee shall select apprentices from a pool of eligible applicants according to the following procedure (ORS 660.137(3)/OEEOA section 6). Once you have been selected from the POE we will invite you to HOSA week, where you will be physically tested on a few construction craft related tasks!




