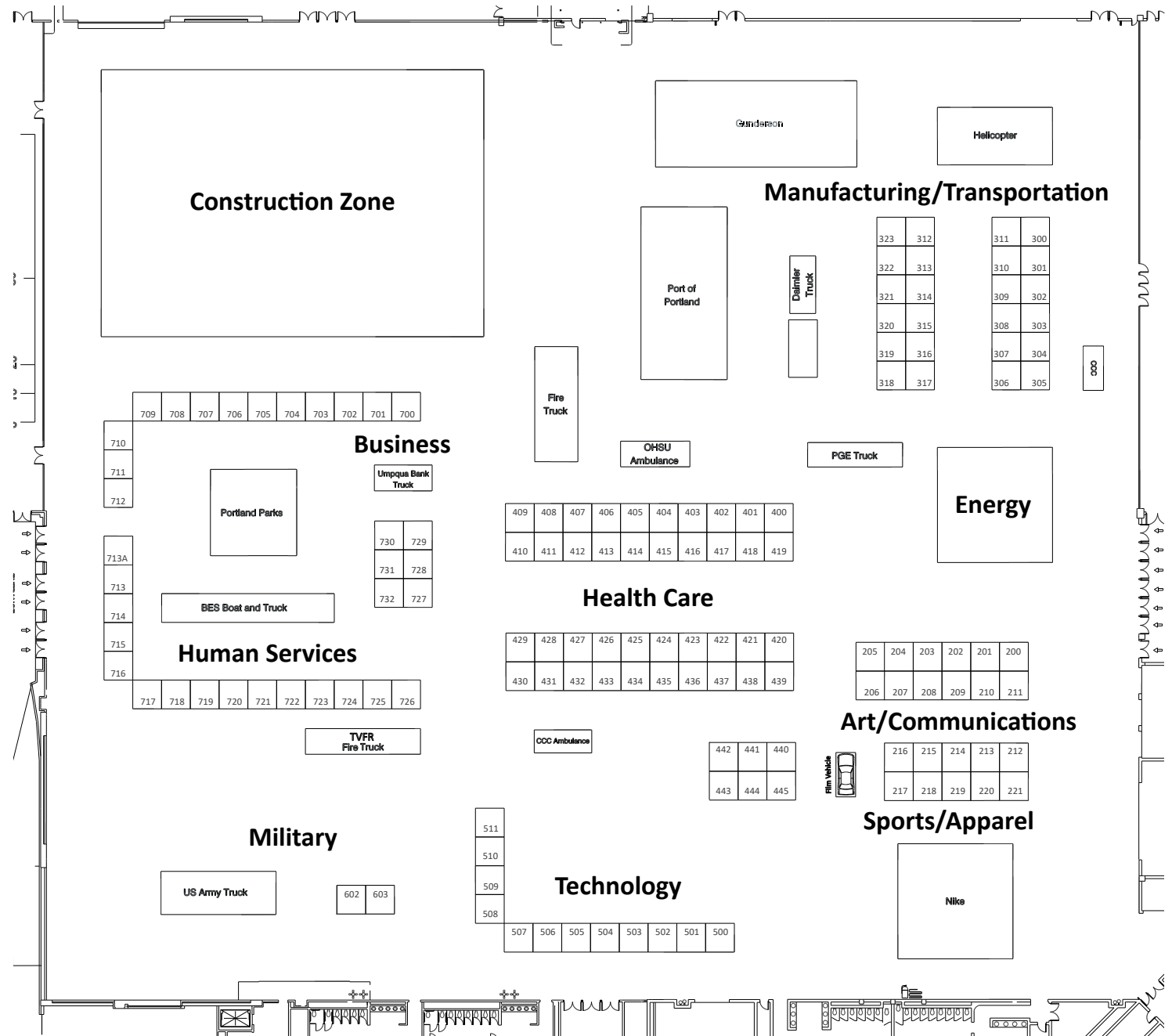
The Portland Workforce Alliance is an independent nonprofit that sees young people as the key to our region's long-term economic prosperity and quality of life.

Along with the Expo, we also provide career days, mentorships, classroom speakers, mock interviews and more.

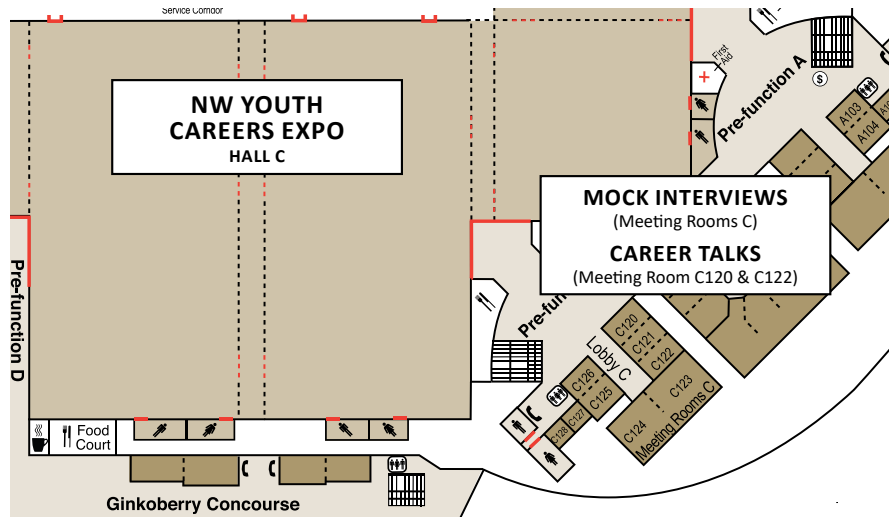

Oregon-Southern Idaho Laborers-Employers Training Trust Apprenticeship Program is a 2-3 year program requiring 4,000 hours of on-the-job (OJT) training and a minimum of 120 hours of related class instruction in core courses and electives in each year of the program for completion.

Minimum Qualifications: Eighteen (18) years of age. Applicant must have a High School diploma, GED, Certificate of High School Equivalency. Work Keys Bronze Level Career Readiness Certificate, or complete a validated Community College test to establish equivalent competency in reading, writing, comprehension and math skills. Applicant must demonstrate capacity to complete the five job related tasks listed in our 4 Hands-On Skills Assessment.

Selection Process: The committee shall select apprentices from a pool of eligible applicants according to the following procedure (ORS 660.137(3)/OEEOA section 6). Once you have been selected from the POE we will invite you to HOSA week, where you will be physically tested on a few construction craft related tasks!
