

CAREER DAYS

For the second year, Design Week Portland and Portland Workforce Alliance partnered to create custom career days for Portland Public high school students. In 2018, we expanded our efforts to 4 different itineraries that served 74 students, inviting them to experience design across many disciplines.

Students began their day with an orientation to the hosting studio and chatted with the creative team there. Then, they worked hands-on in a 2-hour workshop with design mentors. To finish out the day, they toured two additional design businesses to get a sense for other disciplines and spaces.

WORKSHOPS

Students experienced design first hand through 2-hour workshops and master classes, led by leading design professionals.

Neslon Cash and Google mentored students through designing posters in service to a cause and facilitated a group critique.

Second Story engaged students in a challenge to redesign a city bus stop with design thinking and brought in their creative team for feedback.

adidas provided a master class in shoe design and gave students the opportunity to customize their own t-shirts.

Instrument exposed students to five different disciplines represented in their studio through intimate conversations.
