**Booth Fees** (Register before Nov. 30 for a \$50 discount!)

- Private Sector & Government (non-education): \$650 until Nov. 30 / \$700 from Dec. 1 until date of Expo
- For-Profit Education: \$400 until Nov. 30 / \$450 from Dec. 1 until date of Expo
- Education & Non-profit: \$250 until Nov. 30 / \$300 from Dec. 1 until date of Expo

## **Electricity**

The Expo will pay for one (1) 5-amp outlet if ordered **prior to Feb. 1, 2019**.

After February 1, 2019, exhibitors are responsible for their own electrical costs. Each additional 5-amp outlet will cost \$100. An exhibitor manual with order forms will be emailed in February.
