### **Overview & Procedure for Students**

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

This event is available to sophomores, juniors, and seniors attending Tri-county schools. There are 24 total available slots, 6 per Tri-County region.

#### **REGISTRATION**

The list of registered students for each school will be emailed to the school's career center, and students and parents will receive an email notification of registration status (registered or waitlisted) after registration has closed. **Please check your email**.

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

#### **DRESS CODE AND CONDUCT**

Dress appropriately! The dress code is business casual - slacks or nice jeans with no rips or sagging are acceptable, leggings must be covered by a long shirt or skirt. Please wear comfortable, closed-toed shoes and dress for the weather. **NOT ALLOWED:** shorts, caps/hats, t-shirts with objectionable logos/graphics, short skirts, or tops that show the midriff or cleavage. The use of cell phones during the event is not allowed and may result in the phone being confiscated for the duration of the event. Students are expected to fully participate in activities and show respect for the volunteers, STC staff and other students. Students will not be allowed to leave the event early.
