PWA Career Days

When: Thursday, October 15, 2015, and Thursday, April 21, 2016, from 8:45 am to noon.

Who's eligible: Juniors and seniors in Portland Public Schools. All are welcome!

How to register: Space is limited to about 22 seats per career day! Sign up today with your career coordinator. Registration is open now; it closes on Friday, April 15, 2016.

SummerWorks paid internships

When: Summer of 2016 for about 6-9 weeks (180 hours total).

How do they work? This is a separate, additional opportunity offered by Elemental and run through SummerWorks. These internships give young adults, ages 16 and up, a chance to explore careers and learn in greater depth about different aspects of the company, both technical and non-technical. They reflect Elemental's support of gender, racial and socioeconomic diversity.

Who's eligible: Only PPS students who attend a PWA Career Day at Elemental in 2015-16 are eligible to apply. Under guidelines set by SummerWorks and PPS, priority in the competitive application process will be given to students in SummerWorks' target populations, such as students who are lower-income or under-represented in the workforce.

How to apply: SummerWorks' application period opens March 28. Here's what you do:

- **Students who attended the October Career Day:** Fill out SummerWorks' simple online application by the regular program deadline on Monday, April 18. Be sure to list PWA as the community referral partner.
- **Students attending the April Career Day:** We encourage you to apply promptly. However, SummerWorks will briefly extend its regular deadline for students who attend this career day.
