The NW Youth Careers Expo is an opportunity for high school students (9th-12th grade) to explore careers in a wide variety of fields and to learn about the skills and education needed to succeed in the workplace. Preparing Students for the Expo

You will receive an "early edition" NW Youth Careers Expo Teacher Packet with your registration confirmation. The packet will give more detail about the Expo, how to prepare, and suggested activities, including visiting employers' **exhibitor booths** in different career areas, participating in **mock interviews** and attending a **career workshop** on topics such as landing a summer job, acing a job interview or finding hidden, high-paying jobs.
