SCHOOL CHECK IN

The Careers Expo is in Halls D and C of the Oregon Convention Center. Please check in at the registration desk, outside the exhibit hall, with the number of students you brought and your planned departure time. If you do this, we can make announcements to make sure your students remember when you are leaving. We will make announcements at 15 minutes and 5 minutes before your departure time.

BUS UNLOADING, LOADING AND PARKING DETAILS

The Oregon Convention Center prohibits buses from waiting in front of the convention center because it creates major traffic backups and safety issues on MLK. You can have students dropped off and picked up in the pull outs along Holladay (north side) and MLK (east side), but do not block traffic. There is extremely limited parking in the OCC area. We have reserved complimentary bus parking for school districts participating in the Expo. It is at the Rose Quarter Benton Lot at North Benton and North Broadway Avenue.
