




Expo D Hall Main Entrance (Pre-function D)





The High School Journalism Institute is a unique opportunity to achieve experience in real-world reporting. Discover what a career in journalism is all about during this no-cost, week-long program at the Oregon State University (OSU) campus in Corvallis, Ore.

Selected students will benefit from hands-on collaboration with journalists from The Oregonian and other local news organizations to report and produce stories for a special section to be featured in The Oregonian newspaper and on OregonLive.com.

Lodging (OSU residence halls) and meals are provided, and students will learn from the staff of OSU's award-winning student newspaper, "The Barometer." Course credit may also be provided.
