



EVALUATION HIGHLIGHTS

In our exit survey, **96% of students** described the program as **excellent** or **good**, with **88% choosing excellent**.



96% said they felt more aware of health careers and education options.

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79% felt more prepared to pursue college or a future career in nursing.

88% of students said they could picture themselves as a future nurse.

75% said they felt more connected to nursing professionals and students in the healthcare community.



92% of students said they gained insights that will help in any career.



88% said they understand nursing salaries better and ways to earn while you learn

83% said they better understand the skills and traits needed to be a nurse.
